## **Major Demonstration Against Airport Expansion**

It will be the biggest show of unity ever against further expansion of Heathrow. Up to 10 local authorities from across London and Berkshire are joining with campaign groups to stage a spectacular demonstration on 10<sup>th</sup> June.

### **Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> June**

From late morning until early afternoon  
(detailed times below)

- Lorries and Floats
- A Marching Band
- A Procession
- Bouncy Castles
- And the World Cup on a Big Screen!

It is part of the **European Day of Action on Aviation**. At other airports across Europe – including many in the UK – events will be taking place.

## **What will be happening, Where and When**

Each local authority will have its own float which will leave its town hall with some fanfare in mid-morning.

### **11.30 am The procession leaves Harlington**

People who are joining the start of the march are asked to **gather from 11am in Nobel Drive**, very close to the junction of Bath Road and Harlington High Street

- There will be parking available; it is also well served by bus routes (222, 81 and H98 from Hounslow; 105 from Southall; 111 from Heston; 90, 285, 555, 556, 557 from Hatton Cross; 81 from Slough; 222 from West Drayton and Sipson)

**If you want a slightly shorter walk meet at Sipson Recreational Ground on Sipson Way at 11am**

- There will be parking available; it is served by bus routes (222 and 81 from Hounslow; 285 from Hatton Cross; 81 from Slough; 222 from West Drayton)

### **1.00pm Rally and Speeches**

**in the ancient square in Harmondsworth (Harmondsworth High St).**

- Parking available. The U3 bus which runs between Heathrow Airport and Uxbridge via West Drayton serves Harmondsworth. There will also be mini-buses to ferry people back to Harlington.

### **2.00pm England v Paraguay**

**on the Big Screen in a Marquee in Harmondsworth.**
